

THE PROBLEM: Political attacks on your First Amendment rights

THE SOLUTION: The Petition Rights Amendment (PRA)

- Allow petitions. Ballot titles up to 60 words must be in plain English.
- Use the petitioning time 75% of states use. Hold elections in November.
- Prefer regular laws; require 50% more signers for constitutional issues.
- Allow only 12 “emergency” bills yearly. Fewer lawsuits, simpler forms.
